FACT SHEET GLEDITSIA TRIACANTHOS 'HONEY LOCUST'









- Origin: Garden Origin, USA.
- **Habit:** Small, narrow domed deciduous tree with a dense shrubby habit. Slow growing, it can attain dimensions of 4-5m high x 2-3m wide. Broadly pyramidal.
- **Description:** Bright green, elegant leaves up to 16 cm long turning yellow in Autumn.
- **Tolerances:** Adapts to a wide range of conditions and soils but prefers rich moist soils. High pollution and drought tolerance. Not susceptible to any serious pest or disease attacks.
- **Notes:** Good for planting under powerlines in small site. Requires pruning to achieve a single trunk. Attractive large shrub to small tree. A very interesting small, compact form of Gleditsia that will provide year round interest. Excellent for use as a specimen or screening tree in gardens, courtyards, carparks and streets.
